#### **Project Forward 1**

This cross-sectional pilot study evaluated health outcomes in a cohort of childhood cancer survivors (n = 193) diagnosed with any type of cancer from two large pediatric medical centers in Los Angeles County between 2000 and 2007. Participants were diagnosed between the ages 5 and 18 years and were between 15 and 25 years at the time of data collection in 2009; all participants were 2 or more years from treatment for their cancer.
